About the 2020 Census Count Question Resolution (CQR) Operation

Do you believe the 2020 Census did not adequately capture housing unit data or changes in municipal boundaries that may have affected your local population count? If yes, then local officials may ask the Census Bureau to review this by participating in the 2020 Census Count Question Resolution (CQR) Operation.

The operation allows governmental units to identify potential errors in legal boundaries and/or housing counts in their community that may have occurred while processing the 2020 Census. The Census Bureau will accept CQR cases through June 30, 2023.

Who Should Attend?

Representatives from cities, counties, councils of government, and planners are encouraged to attend. The webinar will provide an overview of the CQR program and host local experts who have participated in the program.
